Thank you for asking about campaign sign placement in the City of Bangor. Please be advised of the following:

- Candidate and ballot issue support/promotion signs are allowed on private property in all zoning classifications.
- Maximum size within the City limits is 4' by 4' on commercial and industrial zoned parcels. On residential zoned parcels the maximum size is 2' by 3'.
- Candidate and ballot issue support/promotion signs placed in the right of way along M-43 may be removed by MDOT.
- City personnel may remove candidate support/promotion signs placed in the City of Bangor's rights-of-way.
- While we ask political signs not be placed more than two-weeks prior to the primary election and the general election, be advised this is only a request.
- Signs left in place more than two weeks following the general election are considered abandoned and 'trash and debris.' We may remove them and bill the campaign for these.
- We do not allow candidate or ballot issue support/promotion stickers placed on any City property. This constitutes graffiti and/or vandalism. Campaigns will be asked to remove them immediately. The City may have them removed and bill the campaigns for their removal.
- Lastly, City full and part-time personnel are allowed to make personal endorsements as long as their endorsement does not contain an image or mention of their uniform, city owned vehicles, their City title, or any symbol of the City.
