

Did we Miss Your Leaves, Brush or Yard Wastes?

WE MAKE MISTAKES TOO. BUT, FIRST CHECK AND SEE IF ONE OF THE FOLLOWING MIGHT BE REASONS WE MISSED YOUR LEAVES, YOUR BRUSH OR YOUR YARD WASTES.

IN ORDER FOR US TO GET YOUR BRUSH, LEAVES, GRASS CLIPPINGS, GARDEN OR YARDWASTES . . .

- Please rake your leaves in rows along the road. We can't get big piles like yours.
- Your leaves are raked in rows but they are too far from the road for us to get. Our truck and vacuum arm can't get that far off the road.
- Your leaves are raked in rows but they are mixed with brush, trash or other items that will damage our vacuum if we try to suck them up.
- Your leaves, yard wastes or garden clippings are not in paper or biodegradable bags. We are not able to pick up anything other than paper or biodegradable bags.
- Your leaves, yard wastes and garden clippings are in paper or biodegradable bags but they are mixed with brush, trash or other items that we can not pick them up.
- Your bags are too far from the road for us to get.
- Your Brush is too far from the road for us to get.
- Your Brush is not properly stacked. Please, don't mix other items with the brush.
- Please, place cut ends toward the street.
- The branches are too long or too thick for our chipper. Please, don't put out branches or limbs longer than 10 feet or bigger than 6 inches in diameter.
- Please, re-stack your pile along the street. It is all tangled up. Spread it out more.
- We will take vines but please cut them in 4-foot sections.

Did Reliable Disposal Miss Your Trash Cart?
