

Brush Pick Up

Residents of the City of Bangor can look forward to the City DPW crews picking up brush as a regular weekly service between April 1 and the end of the week of the 15th of November each year.

There are some limitations to the service and residents are asked to help by following the rules below. They are:

- ✓ Brush must be neatly stacked with cut ends pointed toward the street.
- ✓ Leaves, trash or wood must not be mixed in with the brush.
- ✓ Dirt encrusted root balls and trunks will not be picked up.
- ✓ Brush less than 10 foot in length and less than 6 inches diameter will be picked up. Larger pieces cannot be picked up.
- ✓ Vines must be cut in sections of 4 feet or less.
- ✓ All brush must be placed along the curb line or the edge of the road where no curb exists

Brush is picked up on Wednesday.

There may be times when we can't make it on a particular Wednesday. That may be because...

- ✓ The weather is so bad we can't reasonably get around that week
- ✓ City employees are working on some emergencies and are not able to pick up brush.

In these cases, we will try to get the brush on Thursday or Friday or it may have to wait until the following week.
