



Grass Clippings, Yard and Garden Wastes

The City of Bangor wants to help you dispose of yard and garden waste properly. April through November, the City picks up yard and garden wastes that are properly bagged. This means that the grass clippings, flower clippings, garden wastes and other plant materials need to be placed in paper bags or other biodegradable bags. Yes, you may use paper grocery bags.

No plastic bags.

All bags must be placed along the curb line or the edge of the road where no curb exists.

We will not be able to pick the bags up if...

1. Other items (metal, plastic, glass, etc.) are also in the bags.
2. They are too far from the road to be easily seen.
3. They are in plastic bags.

Your cooperation helps us provide this service.

DPW workers try to get bagged wastes every Friday and every Monday.

There may be times when we can't make it on a particular Wednesday. That may be because...

- ✓ The weather is so bad we can't reasonably get around that week
- ✓ City employees are working on some emergencies and are not able to pick up brush.

In these cases, we will try to get the brush on Thursday or Friday or it may have to wait until the following week.
