

SPRING CLEAN-UP

The City of Bangor is happy to provide large item trash pick-up in the Spring of each year. This is a free service. In order to have another successful program, we ask your cooperation again this year.”

NOTE: This is done on two Saturdays in April of each year. The notice below does not provide the actual dates. Check the actual dates each year by calling 427-5831.

- ◆ Start placing your large trash items out along the road on Wednesday April _____, 200____. Have the last of your items out by 9 a.m. on April _____ 1, 200____.
- ◆ Items will be picked up on Saturday April _____ and again on Saturday April _____. Rain or shine we'll be out those two days.
- ◆ The City must charge for car tires (\$5 each), pick-up truck tires (\$10 each) and semi-truck tires (\$25 each) that are picked up.
- ◆ Don't miss this opportunity. Items placed after 9 a.m. on Saturday April _____ will only be picked up at cost. We charge a minimum of \$50 for picking up trash placed out after 9 a.m. on April _____.
- ◆ We cannot pick up hazardous materials like car batteries and appliances with Freon gas such as air conditioners and refrigerators and freezers.
- ◆ We cannot pick up materials from home rehabilitation projects or from demolition projects. If you tear down a shed or garage, we can't get it. If you've ripped out your walls, we can't get it. We also cannot get rocks, dirt or bricks. You will need to arrange for these materials to be hauled away.
- ◆ We will pick up beds, mattresses, carpet, wood, old lumber, boxes, crates, stoves and ranges, dishwashers, fans, lamps, lights, rugs, frames, glass, shoes, clothes, chairs, tables, books, metal and other stuff that is not picked up during weekly trash pick up.
- ◆ Please put metal items in a separate pile. Keep metal items separate from the other stuff.
